RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE QUAKER PENN PARK BOAT RAMP

1. **PERMITS ARE REQUIRED** for use of this facility. Permits may be purchased at the Falls Township Administrative offices.

The season begins April 15th and ends October 15th. The permit fee will not be prorated for partial use.

The permit issued by the Township of Falls must be shown clearly through the front window of the tow vehicle with all important information facing out so as can be clearly read through the front window.

- 2. Motor vehicles are permitted on the ramp for the sole purpose of launching and recovering boats and MUST be removed immediately thereafter.
- 3. Boats may remain at the floating dock as long as is necessary to load or discharge passengers or supplies.
- 4. Boats must not exceed a speed greater than 5 MPH in the no wake zone which extends 100 yards from shoreline.
- 5. All owners will be held fully responsible for any damage caused to property public or private by their boats under anyone's operation.
- 6. Craft requiring Pennsylvania State registration must be registered.
- 7. All discarded trash, litter, bottles, papers or boxes shall be placed in trash receptacles located in the area.
- 8. Swimming or bathing in the vicinity of this facility is NOT PERMITTED.
- 9. Jet skis and other types of water craft shall also be subject to these rules.

THE TOWNSHIP OF FALLS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE OR SUSPEND ANY PERMIT ISSUED BY THEM AS A RESULT OF FAILURE TO OBEY ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES AND REGULATIONS.
