## Residential Accessory Structures

## **Under 500 Sauare Feet**

- 1. A permit is required for all residential accessory structures.
- 2. Residential accessory structures must be located a minimum of 4' from side and rear property lines.
- 3. Residential accessory structures are not permitted in front yards.
- 4. Detached residential accessory structures are permitted to be a maximum of 500 square feet and 16' high. If a residential accessory structure exceeds these dimensions, it must meet the requirements of a principal structure.
- 5. There must be a minimum distance of 10' between buildings on a residential lot.
- 6. Residential accessory structures must be located a minimum of 10 feet from a swimming pool.
- 7. A site plan must be submitted indicating the dimensions, location and setbacks from property lines, between buildings and distance from overhead electrical wires.
- 8. The location and setbacks of all easements on the property must be indicated on the site plan.
- 9. An impervious surface and building coverage calculation sheet must be submitted with all residential accessory structure applications.
- 10. Service entry cables must be located a minimum of 3' horizontal from the accessory structure or a minimum of 4.5 feet above the roof of the structure.

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
