Areas to Consider

- Training
- Policies
- Equipment
- Culture of organization

Training

- Cultural Diversity (MIST)
- Sexual Harassment (Township)
- Excited Delirium (MIST and Township)
 - More likely with methamphetamine, bath salts, synthetic marijuana and PCP.
 - Will resist and fight until they overheat and die.

Training

- Avoiding in-custody injuries and deaths (Township).
- DT training as frequently as firearms training.
 - 3 times a year.
 - UOF laws and FTPD policies included.
- De-escalation training (MIST)


Training

- Procedural Justice (MIST 2 years).
- EMT certified police officers.
 - Goal is 2 on each patrol squad.
 - We need to train more officers.
- We need to continually invest in ongoing training to reinforce these concepts.

Policies

- Bias Based Policing
- Annually, a review of arrests is made.
- An examination of ethnicity and demographics is conducted.
- The new GIS technology will improve our analytical capabilities in this area.

Policies

No indication of bias based policing in FTPD.

Neck restraints have been banned in the FTPD UOF policy for decades.

Equipment

- Restraint belts and leg restraints are in every patrol unit and the cell block.
- Restraint chair in cell block.
- Less lethal options available to officers:
 - Pepper spray.
 - Taser.
 - Baton.
 - Bean bag guns (in supervisor vehicles).

Culture

- De-escalation when possible.
- High value placed on human life.
 - Cardiac and OD examples.
- Our officers are inclined to go "hands on" before using deadly force.
 - Recent Valor awards example.
- Supervision is engaged in operations.

Criminal Justice System

- The "System" is really a group of interdependent systems that need to all work well individually and collectively for there to be justice.
 - Police.
 - District Attorney's Office.
 - Probation and Parole. Adult and Juvenile.
 - Mental Health.
 - Homeless population.
 - Drug and alcohol addiction.

Community

County and local government elected officials.

School District.

Local businesses.
