Requesting a use variance to operate a propane storage business (Section 209-32.3.D.(b); and a challenge to the substantive validity of Section 209-32.3.D.(1)(b) of the Falls Township Zoning Ordinance in accordance with Sections 909.1(a)(1) and 916.1(a)(1) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.

East Coast Propane Expert Witnesses:

Matt Hiltz, Bachelor's Degree in engineering, owner of Hiltz Propane Systems which designs and installs bulk propane storage systems.

Christopher Scott Mohler, Bachelor of Science in Mechnical Engineering, and a professional engineer, licensed in four states – Pennsylvania, Maryland, New Jersey and Massachuetts. Owner of Chestmont Engineering in Exton, Pennsylvania. About 70% of their work is related to either the propane system storage or the actual use of the propane on an industrial or large commercial level.

Township Witnesses:

Thomas Bennett, Zoning Officer and Chief Code Enforcement Officer of Falls Township for six and a half years. The job requires review of plans and letters of intent to determine whether a particular proposed use complies with the Falls Township zoning code.

Charles Guttenplan, Masters Degree in Urban & Regional Planning, and a B.S. degree. Also certified by the American Association of Certified Planners. He is self-employed as a land planning consultant and employed by Whitemarsh Township, Montgomery County as a Director of Planning and Zoning and as their Zoning Officer.

James Sullivan, currently employed at T&M Associates employee for three years, CMX for 7 years (which is the same company as T&M), B.S. degree in civil engineering, a licensed professional engineer in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. He has been in the industry for 33 years.

Richard Dippolito, currently employed as the Fire Marshal of Falls Township for 5 years. Job responsibilities include conducting of fire investigations, supervision the fire inspectors, conducting plan reviews, etc. He is currently a member of Fairless Hills Fire Company and formerly was their fire chief for 20 years.
