Commercial and Industrial – New Construction, Additions and Alterations (Structural, Fire Alarms, Sprinkler Systems)

- \$110.00 per thousand or fraction thereof of the estimated cost of the work for the first \$50,000.00 of work.

Reduction in Building Permit fees for installation of Alternative Energy Technology

Milling, Re-paving and/or Re-striping of Commercial and Industrial Parking Lots

- An Earth Disturbance Permit shall be required if milling exceeds two (2) inches in depth
- For milling that is less than two (2) inches in depth, permit fees are \$50.00 per thousand or fraction thereof of the estimated cost of work, up to a maximum permit fee of \$2,000.00.
