Eligibility

- ✓ Pennsylvania resident
- ✓ Exited a postsecondary study program after June 1, 2021 before obtaining a certificate, associate degree or bachelor's degree
- ✓ Maintained a 2.0 GPA (or higher) prior to exit
- ✓ Able to complete a certificate, associate degree, or bachelor's degree program by June 30, 2024

Participation

- ✓ Attend a postsecondary institution located in Pennsylvania, either in person or online
- ✓ Meet the institution's established program admission requirements
- ✓ Intend to become employed within 12 months of education program completion if currently unemployed
- ✓ FAFSA completion may be required
